POLITICAL BOUNDARIES: 1:24,000 USGS Quadrangles, Parcel data and other survey data.

PUBLIC LANDS: VCGI dataset CadastralPublands_CONSPUB, 2004, a subset of the Vermont Conserved Lands database. It includes land owned by Municipal, State and Federal entities.

PRIVATE CONSERVED LANDS - land in full or partial ownership by 501(c)3 conservation organizations (VLT, TNC, GMC, and others)

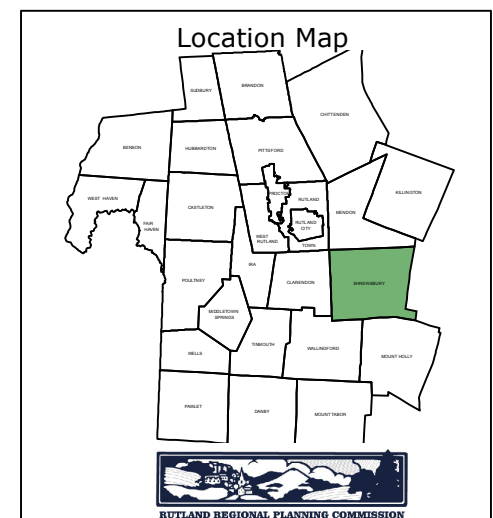
WILDLIFE CORRIDOR RATING - State of VT Department of Fish & Wildlife, VT Agency of Transportation: VT Biodiversity Project.

DEER WINTERING AREAS: 1:24000 AND 1:25000, VANR, 2016.

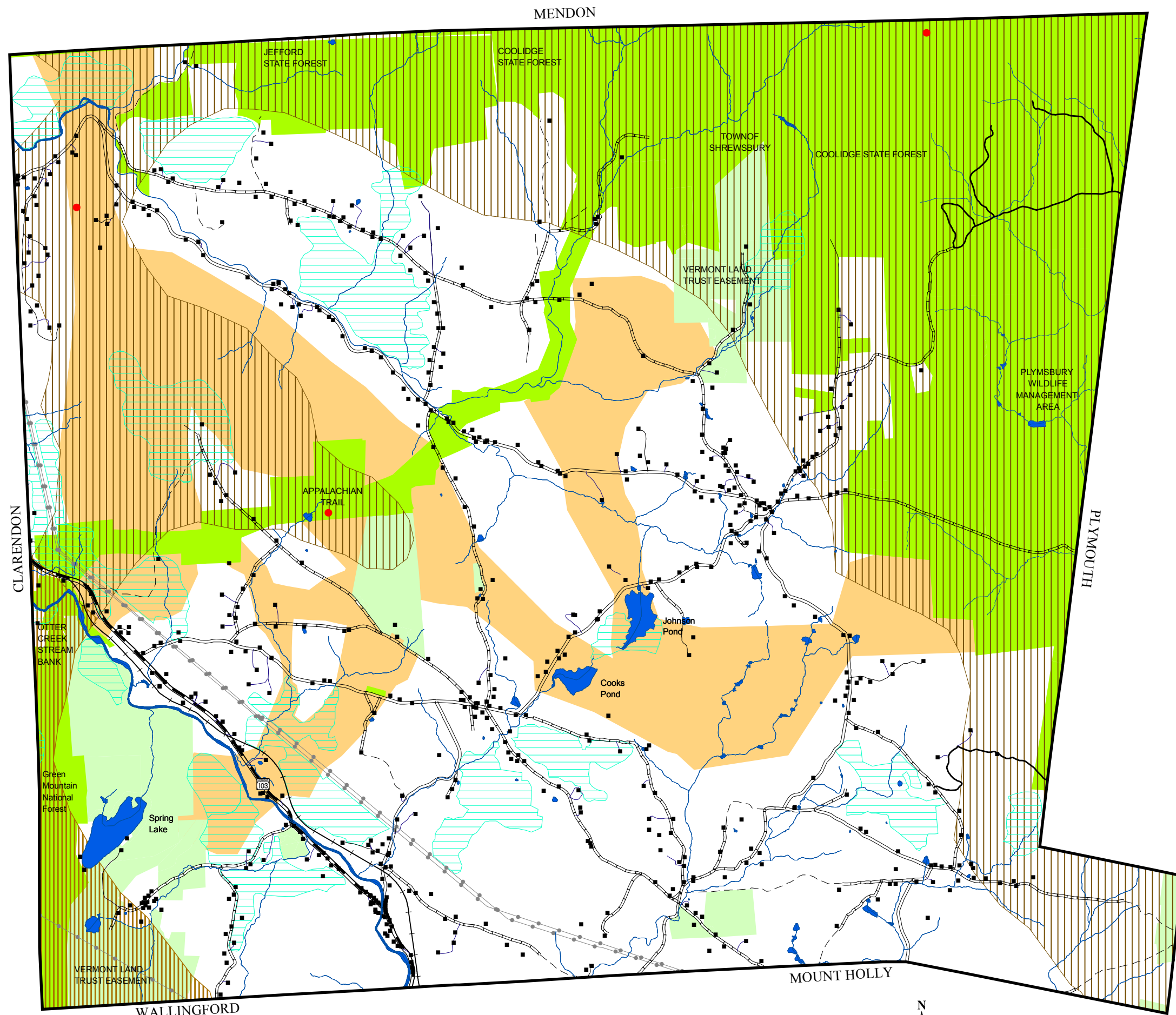
